




After thorough discussion the members of the committee recommend the following for necessary consideration of the Executive Council :


- 1) Only retired professors having age below 70 years are eligible to apply for the Emeritus Professorship of JU.
- 2) The application/nomination in format as designed be addressed to the Vice-Chancellor along with complete C.V. wherein the work/research plan during the tenure of Emeritus Professorship be mentioned clearly.
- 3) The said application/nomination addressed to the Vice-Chancellor must be forwarded by the Board of Studies/Academic Committees and be recommended by the Dean of the concerned faculty.
- 4) The Vice-Chancellor be entrusted to send the application along with C.V. of the concerned professor to two eminent academicians outside the university for vetting. The Dean of the concerned faculty may be consulted by the Vice-Chancellor in this regard.
- 5) The tenure of the Emeritus Professorship in J U is valid for two years initially and this may be renewed subject to review of the performance of the said emeritus professor. However, the Emeritus Professorship should not be given anyone exceeding the limit of 70 years of age.
- 6) For the purpose of renewal of tenure of Emeritus Professorship, the application/nomination be processed at least three months before the expiry of the same. The process for renewal be same as in case of first selection process of Emeritus Professorship, JU as mentioned above, except the vetting of the

- application may be done by one eminent academician (outside the university) in lieu of two.
- 7) The Emeritus Professors of J.U. are not to be eligible for regular honorarium. However to meet the contingency expenses a fund of Rs. 10,000/- may be granted for carrying out his/her research work. The grant for such expenses for Emeritus Professor(s) be shown in the departmental budget separately.
  - 8) Emeritus Professor should have free access to all general facilities as provided by the University. He/she is also eligible for using institutional letter head.
  - 9) S/He may be allowed to take classes if requested by the concerned Board of Studies.
