The history of Jadavpur University, started with the formation of National Council of Education (NCE) with the primary aim to impart education - literary, scientific and technical on national lines exclusively under national control as it was felt to be necessary as a part of Swadeshi movement of Indian struggle for freedom particularly during 1905 – 1906. After Independence, the Govt. of West Bengal, with the concurrence of the Govt. of India, enacted the necessary legislation to establish Jadavpur University on the 24th of Dec 1955. Pioneering efforts of dedicated and learned people of the then Bengal was further carried forward by Dr. TrigunaSen, Prof. M. L. Schroff and many others. Thereafter, sincere effort and dedication has conferred Jadavpur University with excellence thereby achieving the NIRF India Ranking 2017 as the 5th in 'University', 9th in 'Engineering' and 12th in 'Overall' category.

Following the path shown by Prof. M.L. Shroff who introduced pharmacy education in India, Jadavpur University introduced Department Of Pharmaceutical Technology in the year 1963, as the only one of its kind in Eastern India at that time. In today's date, it is well equipped in student and research laboratories with sophisticated and modern analytical instruments and production equipment. Every year there is an intake of about 70 students in B.Pharm, 25 students in M.Pharm and 08 students in PG-Clinical Pharmacy and Pharmacy Practice and also a good number of research fellows are presently working under UGC, DST, AICTE, CSIR, ICMR, DBT and DSA programmes. AICTE sponsored QIP is held twice a year by the QIP Nodal Cell which is attended by faculties of several different institutions. Since long UGC-“Special Assistance Programme (SAP)” and UGC-“University Potential of Excellence (UPE-II)” programme are currently being carried out in this department. International conferences and seminars are often organized in this department such as Prof. Tuhinadri Sen Memorial Seminar, 2018 with renowned national as well as international scientists as speakers and participants from all over India and abroad as well.

Pharmacy as a profession comprising of industrial and practice sectors is an escalating one in today's Indian scenario. Indian pharma industry has experienced a spectacular change in recent times, ranking 4th in volume and 13th in value in the global pharmaceutical market. This has increased the need of more clinically and technologically trained pharmacy professionals who can compete in the global arena by many folds.

This Department of Pharmaceutical Technology of Jadavpur University understands the need to strengthen and upgrade the profession of pharmacy teaching to produce competent professionals. Accordingly, a pilot programme has been organized for the conduct of ‘Continuing Education Programme for Pharmacy Teachers’ in this institution as per the guidelines laid down by the Pharmacy Council of India.

The Pharmacy education and profession in India upto graduate level is regulated by the PCI, a statutory body governed by the provisions of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 passed by the Parliament.

- The Pharmacy Act 1948 was enacted on 4.3.48 with the following preamble- "An Act to regulate the profession of pharmacy. Whereas it is expedient to make better provision for the regulation of the profession and practice of pharmacy and for that purpose to constitute Pharmacy Councils".
- The PCI was constituted on 9.8.49 under section 3 of the Pharmacy Act.

- Regulation of the Pharmacy Education in the Country for the purpose of registration as a pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act.
- Regulation of Profession and Practice of Pharmacy.
