ADMISSION TO THE PH.D.(SC.) PROGRAMME FOR THE SESSION 2019-20

Applications are invited from Indian nationals for admission to the Ph.D.(Sc.) programme as per New Ph.D. Regulation 2017 under the Faculty Council of Science, Jadavpur University. Please see the following note for details:

Note:

1. All applicants must have completed M.Sc. or equivalent examination with requisite marks as mentioned for eligibility in the J.U. Ph.D. Regulation 2017 or equivalent degrees from any university/institute recognized by the UGC.
2. Candidates should apply downloading the Application Form available below in the University website (<http://www.jaduniv.edu.in>).
3. Candidates have to pay the application fees Rs.500/- (per subject) online through SBI Collect system using Credit Card/Debit Card/Net banking after 48 hours of form fill up.
4. After payment, the candidates have to submit the filled up application form along with a photocopy of online payment receipt downloaded from SBI after online payment and have to submit other testimonials as mentioned to the Office of the Dean & Principal Secretary, Faculty Council of Science (U.G. Science Building, Ground Floor, Jadavpur University Main Campus) along with two passport size photographs, self-attested copies of all mark-sheets and certificates, Madhyamik admit card/certificate for verification of age, SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PD certificate (where applicable)/NET/SET certificate (if any) and the candidate should submit the filled up copies of the format for forwarding of Supervisor with consent to supervise from a permanent Teacher/Scientist, and the form be forwarded by the HOD concerned. In case of the candidates apply through the Affiliated Institutes, the application form at first be forwarded by the Director of the Institute and then by the HOD concerned.
5. A candidate who has a two-year M.Phil degree from any university other than Jadavpur University will be required to submit a certificate from the competent authority stating that the selection to the M.Phil course made through a written test and that a full paper of Research Methodology of at least one semester duration was taught in the M.Phil course. Otherwise waiver from WRET and /or course-work shall not be granted.
6. Vacancies shall be as predetermined by the Committee concerned. Vacancy exists in the Department of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Geology and Life Sc. & Biotechnology respectively. No vacancy is available in the Department of Geography and Instrumentation Sc. for this session.
7. Syllabus as per the New Ph.D. Regulation 2017 for Admission Test will be conducted as per approved syllabus of the University.
8. Applications for Ph.D.(Sc.) programme 2019-20 for Admission Test considered up to 29th April 2019 and the Admission Test will be held in 28th & 29th May 2019 tentatively.
9. Format for forwarding from the Proposed Supervisor will be available in the office of the Faculty Council of Science.
10. Institutional fellowship is not available.
11. Candidates are requested to follow the website notifications time to time for any changes in this regard.
