

## NOTICE FOR ADMISSION IN LANGUAGE AND LINGUISTIC COURSES, 2022

Applications are invited from Foreign Nationals for admission in the following Certificate, Diploma and Advanced Diploma Courses in Indian and Foreign Languages. These courses are of one year duration and will commence in February, 2022 with final examination at the end of January 2023. Classes for language courses are held twice a week in the evening between 5pm and 8pm. Classes for One Year Certificate Course in Introduction to Linguistics are held thrice in the evening. Online or physical mode classes will be held following directives from Jadavpur University and Government of West Bengal. In the event of online classes, classes will be held using platforms like Google Meet etc. and the materials used for teaching as well as learning will be circulated online.

Minimum qualification: Higher Secondary Examination (Class XII) or equivalent
