Admission to the Ph.D Programme Session: January, 2022

Students pursuing M.Phil in Sanskrit from Jadavpur University and also holding fellowships like JRF/NFSC/NFST/ NFOBC/NFPWD etc having 55% marks in M.Phil course work are invited to apply for admission to the Ph.D. programme (Arts) session January, 2022, under supernumerary category only in the Department of Sanskrit.

Process of Application:

- Candidates should apply in the prescribed form available on the website. www.jaduniv.edu.in.
- Candidates have to pay the application fees Rs. 500/- online through SBI Collect System using Credit Card/Debit Card/Net Banking.
- After payment the downloaded form along with a online payment receipt and all testimonials is to be submitted to the Ph.D Cell, Arts, Subarna Jayanti Bhavan, Ground floor, Jadavpur University Main campus, Kolkata 700032.
- **The last date for online payment is 23.05.2022**
- **The last date for submission of form is 25.05.2022**

The following documents should be attached with the application form:

- i) Two recent passport size photographs.
 - ii) Attested copies of all mark-sheets and certificates, Madhyamik admit card/certificate for verification of age, SC/ST/ OBC-A/OBC-B /PD certificate, where applicable. NET/SET/GATE certificate, if any.
 - iii) Attested copies of valid documents of fellowships like JRF/NFSC/NFST/ NFOBC/NFPWD etc.
 - iv) Online payment receipt downloaded from SBI server after online payment.
- **As per circular Nos. BC-16014/1/82-SC dt.06/08/1984 & BCD-1, D.O.12017/11/89-SCD(R.CELL) dt.09/01/1990 and letter No.1510-SCW dt.31/05/2007 of the Government of West Bengal, the Scheduled Castes/ the Scheduled Tribes of the states other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in educational institutions in West Bengal unless they can produce Domicile Certificate as a proof for residing in West Bengal for at least 10 years issued by the competent authority.**
 - **A Candidate applying for seat reserved for the OBC-A / OBC-B category (wherever applicable)**

must produce an OBC certificate (the issues date of which should not be earlier than April 2021) issued by the competent authority that clearly indicates (i) the category (A or B) he/she belongs to: (ii) that he/she does not belong to creamy layer of the society. Without submission of such an appropriate certificate, the applicant shall NOT be considered for seats reserved for OBC-A / OBC-B category.

As per the rules of Government of West Bengal, the OBC-A and OBC-B candidates of the states other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in educational institutions in West Bengal unless they can produce Domicile Certificate as a proof for residing in West Bengal for at least 10 years issued by the competent authority.

- M.Phil students of Jadavpur University who have successfully defended their viva-voce examinations having 55% marks in M.Phil course work and have valid Continuing UGC Fellowship (NET-JRF/RGNF/Moulana Azad and the like) may apply. They may be considered under Continuing Fellowship Holder category provided they have *not* registered themselves in any other university/Institute after completing their M.Phil degrees at Jadavpur University. The gap period between the date of publication of Final M.Phil result and registration/enrollment in the Ph.D. programme (if selected) must NOT be more than one year.
- An applicant shall *not* be considered for admission if
 - (i) s/he is already enrolled in a Ph.D. programme in any other university/institute or in any other department of Jadavpur University.
 - (ii) a) s/he is pursuing 2-Year M.Phil. in the relevant subjects where the submission of M.Phil dissertations and the viva-voce could not be held on or before 16.05.2022 and
b) s/he is pursuing 2-Year M.Phil. in the relevant subjects but has failed in the viva-voce examination held on or before 16.05.2022.
