The NIRF India Rankings-2022 has ranked Jadavpur University in the 4th position among the Universities and 12th position in the “Overall” Category. The University is also ranked 11th in the “Engineering” and 13th in the “Research Institution” categories. The position of the University has significantly improved from the last year’s 8th rank in the University category and 17th in both Engineering and Research categories. The overall rank of the University places it in the first position among all the State Universities in the country this year. This is indeed a stellar achievement, made possible by the dedicated team work involving all sections of the University community – students, researchers, teachers, officers and employees. It is an apt recognition of our University’s constant quest for excellence amidst all odds.

I am sure the University community will work together so that deficiencies in the parameters can be rectified, which should enable us to move further up in future NIRF rankings.
